



SEASONAL SITE CAMPSITE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Dear Camper:

The following terms and conditions are intended to help keep your stay in our parks safe and enjoyable for yourself and others and to prevent damage to the natural environment of the park. Failure to abide by them may result in the cancellation of your permit and eviction from the park.

1. All persons must comply with orders given by a Park Officer.
2. Obey all posted park rules.
3. Obey posted speed limits.
4. Wood cannot be collected within the park. This includes, removing branches from trees or shrubs, cutting down trees or shrubs, and collecting deadwood found in the park.
5. Obey quiet hours, where posted. Quiet hours are from 10:30 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Note: This includes any type of portable generator and motor vehicle.
6. Visitor(s) (unregistered guest) are not permitted during posted quiet hours.
7. The permit holder is responsible for activities occurring at the campsite.
 - All equipment i.e. tents, campers, trailers, vehicles will be on the site pad, not in the trees or on the roadside. **Only one (1) licensed camping unit allowed per site.**
 - Sites are not to be altered in any fashion i.e. extending of site pads, moving of picnic tables and fire-rings, building of fire-pits, construction activity.
 - The site is for use by the Permit Holder and immediate family members only and the permit holder is responsible for all persons on the site.
8. Campsites must be kept clean at all times. At the end of the season, the Permit Holder will clean up the site, to be left in a state as first occupied at the start of the season.
9. Pets must be on a leash(s) at all times and are not allowed to run at large at any place in the Park (including the beach for health reasons). You are responsible for keeping your pets quiet and must not leave them unattended if you leave the Park.
10. Motor vehicles are permitted in the parks on authorized roadways only.
11. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is restricted to individuals 19 years and older. Open liquor is restricted to your campsite.
12. Fires are restricted to fire-rings and may not be left unattended. (This includes when leaving the Park or retiring for the night.)
13. Permits are non-transferable.

We hope your stay at the campground is a pleasant one. If you have any questions or concerns please contact the Park Operator.
