BENEFITS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES BUSINESS INCENTIVE AND CONTRACT REGISTRY PROGRAMS

The Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Business Incentive and Contract Registry programs provides the following advantages for eligible businesses:

- Interested businesses have a fair opportunity to compete on government contracts. GNWT contract opportunities valued over \$5,000 are publicly advertised along with award results on one central website at: <u>www.contractregistry.nt.ca/Public/PublicHome.asp</u>. The National Contract Opportunities listing is also available free of charge at: <u>www.marcan.net/english/search_new.htm</u>;
- Tenders Any business submitting tenders on government contracts may be eligible to receive a 15 percent bid adjustment for goods and services provided by BIP Approved Northern Businesses and an additional 5 percent for goods and services provided by BIP Approved "Local" Businesses, if the business is "local" i.e., located in the community where the goods or services are required;
- Requests for Proposals Any business submitting proposals on government contracts may be eligible to receive 15 points for goods and services provided by BIP Approved Northern Businesses, and an additional 5 points for goods and services provided by BIP Approved "Local" Businesses;
- Under \$5,000 Goods and services valued under \$5,000 are purchased directly from BIP Approved Northern Businesses;
- Payments BIP Approved Northern/Local Businesses are paid 20 calendar days after receipt
 of invoice, receipt of goods or services or completion of construction, whichever is latest. Or in
 the case of credit card purchases, payments are paid immediately. The standard payment
 terms are 30 days; and
- BIP Registry the registry of approximately 1,200 Approved Northern Businesses is published and promoted on the World Wide Web at: <u>www.bipregistry.nt.ca</u>.

APPLICANT:

- 1. Business Name is the name registered and indicated on the NWT Legal Registration Certificate
- 2. **Mailing Address** is the address where the business receives its mail.
- 3. **Community** is the NWT community the business is located in.
- 4. **Postal Code** is the postal code for the businesses mailing address.
- 5. **Street Address** are the premises where the business physically operates from
- 6. **Number of Permanent Employees** is the number of employees that the business employs on an annual basis, (this does not include seasonal or part time/casual employees)
- 7. **Resident Manager Name** is the individual designated by the business to undertake all aspects of management and has absolute decision-making authority over day-to-day matters.
- 8. **Phone/Fax** is the NWT phone and fax number of the business
- 9. **Business Type** is the type of business organization that has been established for the Business Name (There are four Business Types; *Sole Proprietorship, Partnership, Corporation/Limited Company, Co-operative*).

This document verifies that the business name has been legally registered to conduct business in the NWT and is in good standing with the Department of Justice, Corporate Registries Division. - 3. **Current Business License** is a document evidencing that the business name has been licensed to conduct business in the NWT community indicated on the application. The document is issued by a NWT Municipality or for those municipalities that do not issue business licenses, by the GNWT Department of Municipal and Community Affairs, Consumer Services Division, telephone: 867-920-8059.
- 4. Proof of Residency in the NWT for the last twelve months is required for Majority Owner(s) such as:
 - Valid NWT Health Care Card (Mandatory)
 - Plus one of the following:
 - NWT Drivers License issued at least 12 months prior to application date
 - Notice of Assessment from Canada Revenue Agency on NWT Residency Deduction
- 5. Proof of Residency in the NWT for the last six months is required for Resident Managers.
- 6. **Proof of ownership or lease for the premises indicated on the application** on an annual basis for the primary purpose of operating the subject business.
- 7. **Share Registry** if the business is a limited or incorporated company, a copy of the business' share registry is required. This document is usually retained at the business' Registered Office (lawyer). This document shows who the shareholders are and how the shares are distributed.
