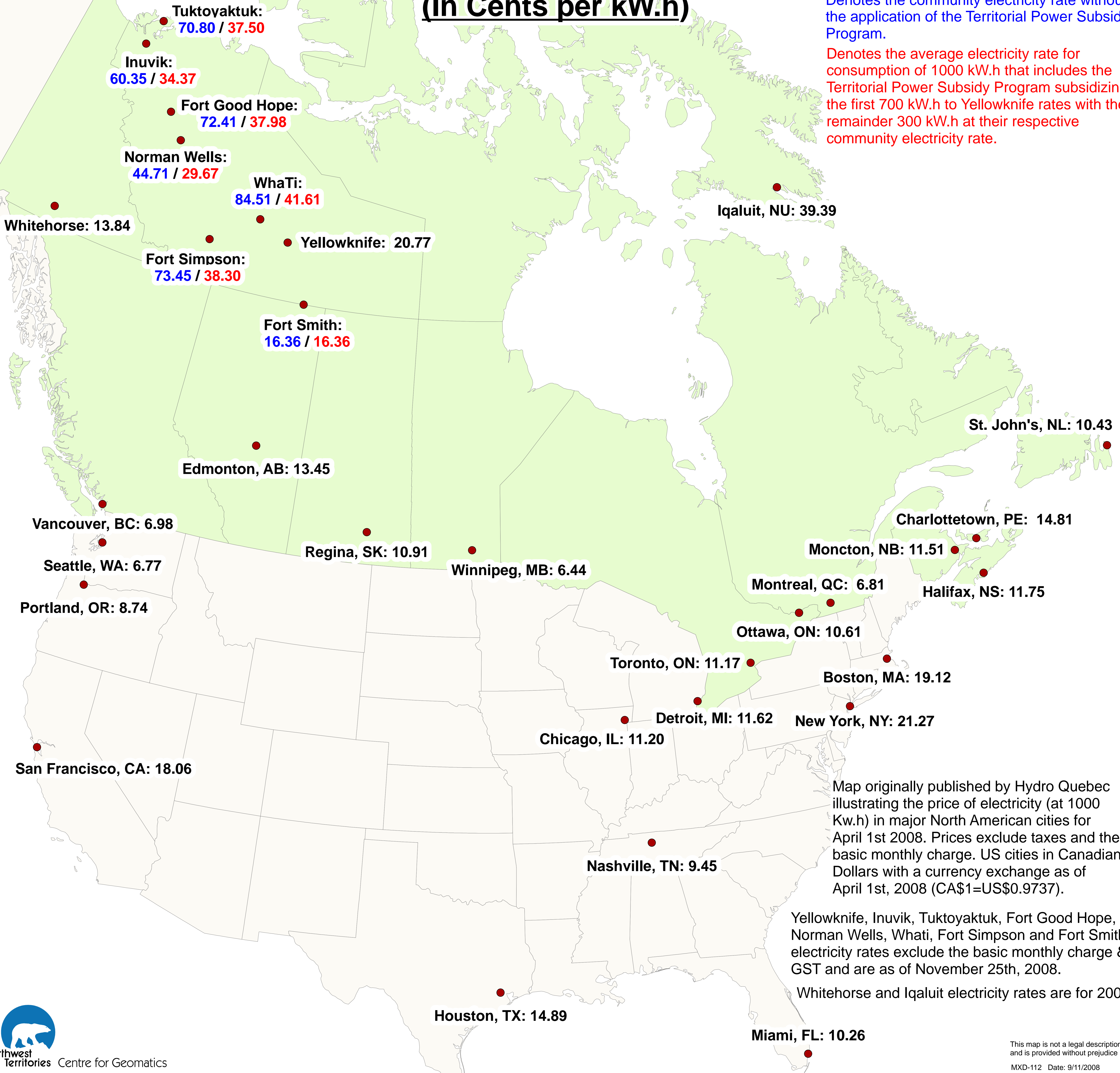


Electricity Rates for 1,000 kW.h in North America

(In Cents per kW.h)

Denotes the community electricity rate without the application of the Territorial Power Subsidy Program.

Denotes the average electricity rate for consumption of 1000 kW.h that includes the Territorial Power Subsidy Program subsidizing the first 700 kW.h to Yellowknife rates with the remainder 300 kW.h at their respective community electricity rate.



Map originally published by Hydro Quebec illustrating the price of electricity (at 1000 Kw.h) in major North American cities for April 1st 2008. Prices exclude taxes and the basic monthly charge. US cities in Canadian Dollars with a currency exchange as of April 1st, 2008 (CA\$1=US\$0.9737).

Yellowknife, Inuvik, Tuktoyaktuk, Fort Good Hope, Norman Wells, WhaTi, Fort Simpson and Fort Smith electricity rates exclude the basic monthly charge & GST and are as of November 25th, 2008.
