PREFACE


The Department of Industry, Tourism and Investment (ITI), of the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) has a mandate to promote economic self-sufficiency by means of funding and support initiatives designed to foster a positive economic environment in our territory.

This is done through several measures, including the delivery and management of financial contribution programs to clients and agencies in a variety of sectors.

This report provides a summary of contributions provided throughout the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

In the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the GNWT, through ITI, provided \$21.9 million in financial support to 785 individuals, entrepreneurs, businesses, governments, and groups across the Northwest Territories (NWT).

MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS

The GNWT provided \$6.2 million in funding for two major NWT wide organizations which, collectively, had a significant impact on the NWT economy and the wellbeing of individual entrepreneurs and businesses. (Table 1)

A total of 32 major contributions (more than \$100,000) totaling \$6.5 million were made to community, regional and territorial organizations, governments and educational institutions in 2023-2024. (Table 2)

COMMUNITY, REGION, AND TERRITORIAL RESULTS

Contributions are categorized into three overarching community groupings: Yellowknife, Hay River, Inuvik and Fort Smith are categorized as **Level 1** communities. The NWT's 30 remaining communities are identified as **Level 2** communities. Projects that serve more than one community are identified as **Pan-territorial**.

In 2023-2024 24 per cent of contributions went to 30 designated Level 2 communities.

Table 3 shows the allocation of contributions by community and region and notes the total of contributions made to clients serving, all or, a number of communities.

Chart 2 - Distribution of funding by region 2023-2024 (\$21,993,852)





Chart 3 – Contribution Distribution by Community Level.



SECTOR DISTRIBUTION

The Department's grants and contribution programs are structured to support three broad investment themes or pillars representing support to the economy of the NWT.

- Business Services are contributions designed to support the development of small and medium sized business, and manufacturing in the NWT.
- Investing in Diversity encompasses programming around tourism, arts, film, commercial fishing, agriculture, and the traditional economy.
- Unlocking Our Potential contributions provide support for the development of the mineral and petroleum economic sectors and the NWT Geological Survey.

As shown in Table 4, contributions described under Business Services accounted for 47 per cent of the Department's overall grants and contributions.


These contributions are under the Support for Entrepreneurs and Economic Development (SEED) program and through business-support agencies including Community Futures Organizations and Prosper NWT (formerly known as the Business Development and Investment Corporation).

Contributions to parks and tourism-related businesses and initiatives accounted for nearly 27 per cent of total grants and contributions. ITI administered over 28 separate funding programs and disbursements in the 2023-2024 fiscal year.


PRÉFACE

Le ministère de l'Industrie, du Tourisme et de l'Investissement (MITI) du gouvernement des Territoires du Nord-Ouest (GTNO) est chargé de promouvoir l'autosuffisance économique au moyen de programmes de financement et d'initiatives de soutien conçus pour favoriser un environnement économique favorable dans notre territoire.

Cette mission est accomplie de diverses façons, notamment par l'exécution et la gestion de programmes de contributions financières destinés aux clients et aux organismes qui œuvrent dans divers secteurs.

Le présent rapport résume les contributions versées au cours de l'exercice 2023-2024, durant lequel le MITI a versé 21,9 millions de dollars en aide financière à plus de 785 particuliers, entrepreneurs, entreprises, gouvernements et groupes à l'échelle des Territoires du Nord-Ouest (TNO).

CONTRIBUTIONS D'ENVERGURE

Le GTNO a accordé 6,2 millions de dollars en financement à deux organismes qui mènent des activités à l'échelle territoriale et qui ont une incidence importante sur le bien-être économique des entrepreneurs et des entreprises des TNO (Tableau 1).

Au total, 32 contributions d'envergure (plus de 100 000 \$) totalisant 6,5 millions de dollars ont été accordées à des organisations, à des gouvernements et à des établissements d'enseignement communautaires, régionaux et territoriaux en 2023-2024 (Tableau 2).

- les **projets panterritoriaux** (les projets qui visent plus d'une collectivité).


En 2023-2024, 24 % des contributions ont été accordées à 30 collectivités désignées de niveau 2.



DISTRIBUTION PAR SECTEUR

Les programmes de subventions et de contributions du Ministère ont été conçus de façon à cibler trois grands secteurs d'investissement représentant le soutien à l'économie des TNO.

- Dans les Services aux entreprises, on retrouve les contributions destinées à soutenir le développement des petites et moyennes entreprises et du secteur manufacturier aux TNO.
- Le volet Investir dans la diversité comprend des programmes axés sur le tourisme, les arts, le cinéma, la pêche commerciale, l'agriculture et l'économie traditionnelle.
- Le volet Explorons notre potentiel comprend des contributions qui soutiennent la Commission géologique des TNO, ainsi que les secteurs économiques des minéraux et du pétrole.

Comme indiqué dans le tableau 4, les contributions décrites dans Services aux entreprises comptent pour 47 % de l'ensemble des subventions et contributions du Ministère.


Ces contributions sont versées dans le cadre du Programme d'appui aux entrepreneurs et au développement économique (PAEDE) et par l'entremise de divers organismes de soutien aux entreprises, notamment les organisations d'aide au développement des collectivités du Nord et la Société d'investissement et de développement.

Les contributions aux parcs ainsi qu'aux entreprises et aux initiatives liées au tourisme ont représenté 27 % du total des subventions et contributions. Le MITI a administré plus de 28 programmes de financement distincts au cours de l'exercice 2023-2024.

PROGRAM RESULTS REPORTING

BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Community futures program

Purpose

Community Futures Development Corporations (CFDCs) operate independently of government as non-profit organizations overseen by volunteer Boards of Directors representative of the region and communities that they serve. CFDCs provide access to capital and business support services to entrepreneurs and businesses in their operating area.

The GNWT supports CFDCs by providing contribution funding for their operations under ITI's Community Futures Program.

Results Reporting

In the 2023-2024 fiscal year, \$690,000 were provided to Community Futures Development Corporations throughout the NWT (Table 6).

COMMUNITY TRANSFER INITIATIVE

Purpose

Under the Community Transfer Initiative (CTI), contribution funding for salary and operations is provided to Northwest Territories community governments or designated organizations to employ Economic Development Officers (EDO). CTI EDOs deliver ITI programming as well as assisting with and direct economic development initiatives in the community they serve.

Results Reporting

Results of the Community Transfer Initiative are reported by the funding recipients to ITI's Regional Offices. Reporting includes an annual operational plan, a quarterly activity report and a performance appraisal for the EDO.

For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, 14 NWT communities participated in the Community Transfer Initiative. \$1.6 million in funding was contributed.

Chart 5 provides a summary of transfer amounts for the past three fiscal years while Table 7 shows Community Transfer Initiative funding by community.

Chart 5: Summary of the Community Transfer Initiative 2021-2022 to 2023-2024



SUPPORT FOR ENTREPRENEURS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Purpose

The Support for Entrepreneurs and Economic Development Policy (SEED) provides contribution funding across six different programs that support entrepreneurs, businesses or residents to start a business, or develop capacity or skills. SEED funding can also be used to support projects or events that help communities stimulate their local economies.


Results Reporting

In the 2023-2024 fiscal year the SEED Policy budget was augmented by enhanced funding for the Arts Economic Development Pilot Program and by the Canadian Northern Economic Development Agency (to help with Wildfire Response Relief funding provided through the SEED Policy).

In all, ITI provided \$5.8 million (Chart 6) in SEED Policy contributions to 649 individuals, businesses, and organizations. Regular SEED Policy contributions comprised \$3.2 million (\$3.6 million in 2022-2023), \$2.3 million in Wildfire Response Relief, and \$298,000 in Arts Economic Development Pilot Program funding.

ECONOMIC DIVERSIFICATION

AGRICULTURE & FISHERIES

The food production sector is important to the Northwest Territories in many ways. It is at the confluence of culture, economic diversity and food security, and is the heart of a thriving territory.

SUSTAINABLE CANADIAN AGRICULTURAL PARTNERSHIP (Sustainable CAP)

Background to Multilateral Agreement

The five-year multilateral Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership (Sustainable CAP) came into effect on April 1, 2023, and expires March 31, 2028. Its goal is to support projects and initiatives that support the following collective outcomes:

- Improve sector environmental performance, adaptation to climate change and reduction of greenhouse gas emissions.
- Increase sector capacity and growth across the entire agri-food value chain; and,
- Enhance sector resiliency, diversity, equity and inclusion, and public trust.

Sustainable CAP is cost shared between the federal, provincial and territorial governments, with the federal government contributing 60 per cent of the costs of the program and the provincial/territorial government contributing 40 per cent. The 2023-2024 federal government contribution was \$904,855 while the GNWT provided \$603,236.

Results Reporting

Actual expenditures by ITI as the GNWT's cost shared portion of Sustainable CAP were \$603,236.

NORTHERN FOOD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Purpose

To remove barriers, create employment and develop the NWT food production sector by supporting producers of northern fish, meat and other food products made available for sale to NWT consumers.

Results Reporting

For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, ITI provided \$539,573 in direct funding through the Northern Food Development Program to individuals, businesses, educational institutions, and Indigenous governments in all five regions across the NWT as shown in Table 12.

INDIGENOUS CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAM

Purpose

The Indigenous Capacity Building (ICB) pilot program helps fund opportunities and activities to increase Indigenous engagement with, participation in, and understanding of the resource industry. This includes indigenous involvement in the function, regulation, and the benefits resulting from resource exploration and development. The program is designed to help territorial Indigenous governments and organizations:

- actively participate in and benefit from all aspects of the NWT resource sector;
- promote regional mineral potential to attract industry investment;
- increase capacity to plan, pursue, and participate in economic opportunities in the NWT resource sector; and
- benefit from opportunities in all stages of the resource exploration and development processes in the NWT.

Results Reporting

In 2023-2024, 14 Indigenous governments and organizations received a total of \$120,742 to attend 6 different Mineral and Petroleum focused conferences, symposia and workshops.
