

EVALUATION AND DECISION-MAKING CRITERIA

Applications will be evaluated on a first-come, first-served basis beginning April 1st of each fiscal year. Applicants that meet eligibility requirements detailed in the Producers Incentive Pilot Program (PIPP) policy will be assessed according to the following grading rubric.
